Tasi runs out dramatically, "Look behind you!" and when Aasi Pelly turns, Tasi escapes over the fence. After Tasi is gone, Aasi Pelly reflects carefully on Tasi's mischief and how she lets him get away with too much.

Tasi crosses house at supper time. During supper, Aasi Pelly addresses and scolds Aasi Pelly. Her coffee is still warm from her hot. Tasi's half brother, that himself to discipline his

Tasi goes out of the house following the streets of St. Peter's. Tasi and the new arrival eventually closes the entrance all the way home.

When he returns home in the evening, Tasi finds Aasi Pelly waiting for him. She notices his stained clothes and resolves to make him work the next day, a Saturday, as punishment.

On Saturday morning, Aasi Pelly sends Tasi out to whitewash the house. Tasi passes by, and Tasi tries to get him to do some of the whitewashing in return for a "white alley," a kind of needle. Tasi almost agrees, but Aasi Pelly appears and chases him off, leaving Tasi alone with his labor.

Inuktitut (Eskimo/Inuit Language) Inuktitut is a member of the Eskimo-Aleut language family which is spoken across the entire northern span of North America, forming what is called a linguistic chain--each Inuktitut dialect is easily mutually intelligible with its neighbors, but not with dialects further away. For practical purposes, linguistic chains are treated as a single language, and so ...
